For best results, print the front cover on white card, and use a piece of card for the back cover. Bind the book so your child can easily turn the pages, or you could use a clear folder.

- Use pictures that can be put with the letters 'Sound'. ie 'a' f or apple NOT 'a' f or ape.
- Find pictures to cut out and stick in the abc book. Stickers are also a good source. Or use photographs. Eg, a photograph of YOUR house ('h' f or house) or 'b' f or a photo of THEI R bed! Or let your child draw around their hand - 'h' f or hand. 'f' f or f oot!
- Write the word under the picture.
- Let your child colour in the letters at the top of the page.
- Concentrate on one letter at a time.
- Fill up the pages with as many things beginning with the letter sound as you can.
- Have fun cuddling up on the sofa and reading 'their' book!
